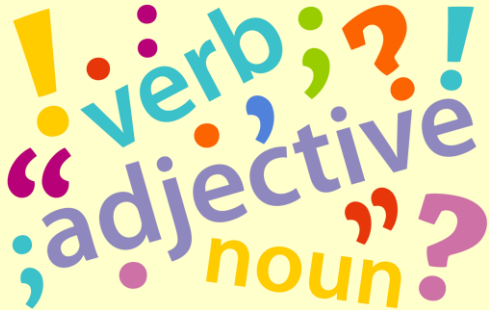

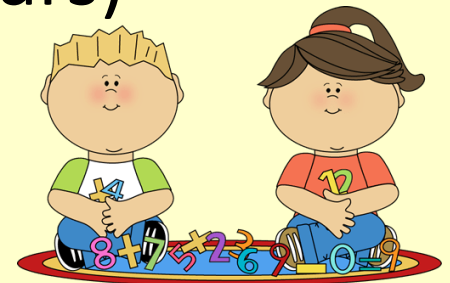

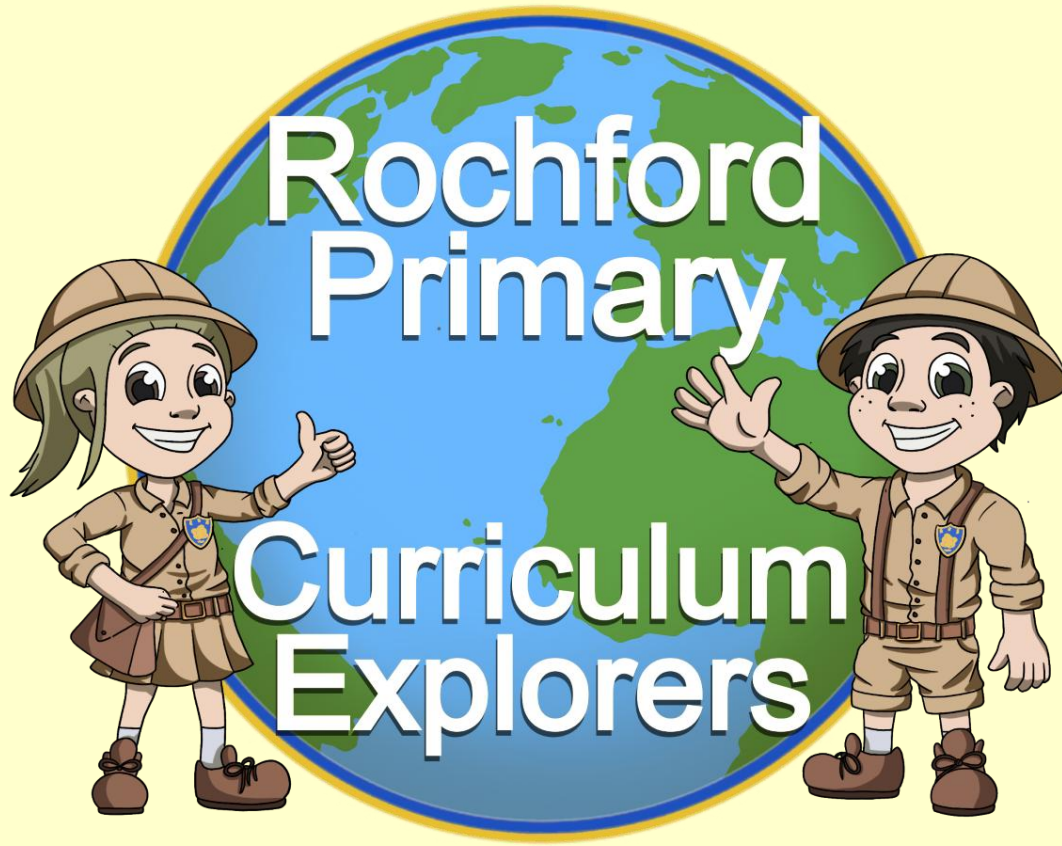

Foundations First - Success Follows



We believe strong foundations lead to greater success, so this year homework will concentrate on the essential skills of reading, spelling and times tables which underpin learning across the curriculum.

Reading

Reading Choice books will be sent home regularly. Your child is expected to log reading onto Boom Reader **at least twice a week.**

On Google Classroom you will find helpful tips for reading at home with your child.

Spelling

Spellings will be set each **Monday** weekly.

Children need to practise spellings **4 times a week** and complete the spelling homework sheet.

Children should spend **2 x 20min** sessions on Spelling Shed each week.

Times Tables

Children should spend **2 x 20min** sessions on TTR each week.

Children should complete and upload **1 times table** activity per week.

When learning tables include the division facts
e.g.: $8 \times 4 = 32$, so $32 \div 4 = 8$

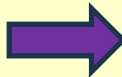


Times Tables

If you have any questions about the new approach, Miss Craddick will be happy to answer them.

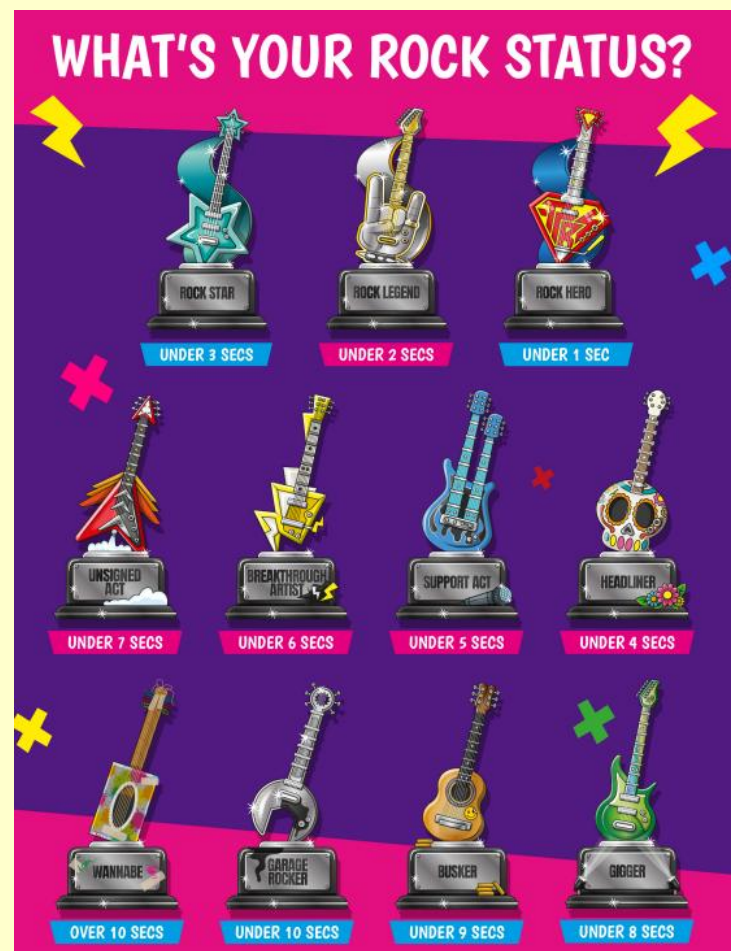


Times Tables
