Our SEND Offer

At Rochford Primary and Nursery School, we provide an inclusive learning environment where pupils with special educational needs and disabilities are supported to access learning and achieve their potential. Provision is responsive and adapted to meet individual need.

How we support pupils with SEND

Support may include:

- High-quality classroom teaching
- Adaptive teaching approaches
- Reasonable adjustments to remove barriers
- Targeted support where appropriate
- Access to external professional advice when needed

Areas of need supported

We support pupils across the four areas of SEND:

- Communication and Interaction
- Cognition and Learning
- Social, Emotional and Mental Health
- Sensory and Physical Needs

We also support pupils with medical needs where appropriate arrangements are in place.

Working with families

We recognise the importance of working in partnership with parents and carers and ensure families are involved in supporting pupil progress where appropriate.

Pupil involvement

Pupils are supported to share their views about their learning and support needs, and these are considered when planning provision.

Inclusive learning environment

All pupils have access to a broad and balanced curriculum. Reasonable adjustments are made where needed to support full participation in school life.

External support

Where appropriate, we work with external professionals including:

- Speech and Language Therapy
- Educational Psychology
- Sensory Impairment Services
- School Nursing Service
- Local Authority Inclusion Partners

Transitions

We support pupils at key transition points, including entry into school and transition to secondary education. Additional support is provided where appropriate for pupils with SEND.
